Early Season Action Heats Up

Late-inning heroics, long balls and lights-out pitching highlighted Week 3 action in the West Suburban Baseball League. The league's competitiveness was evident, as just 11 of the WSBL's 61 teams remained undefeated.

At the 12U level, the Oak Brook Outlaws lead the way with a 3-0 ledger, followed closely by the Darien Hornets (2-0) and Westdale Warriors (2-0). Three teams at the 11U level – Wheaton-Briarcliffe Blazers, DuPage Dingers and Plainfield Panthers – all started the season 3-0. The Bloomingdale Bulldogs (4-0) and Lisle Wolves (3-0) are the early-season division leaders at 10U.
