WSBL Completes First Month of Play

The first month of play in the West Suburban Baseball League ended with a number of hotly-contested games and outstanding individual and team performances at all three age levels.

At the 12U level, the Oak Brook Outlaws (4-0), Winfield Wolves (4-1), Downers Grove Longshots-Teal (5-1), Darien Hornets (4-1), Westdale Warriors (3-0), and Western Springs Hurricanes (3-0) led their respective divisions.
