## WSBL All-Star Games, Skills Competitions This Saturday

The West Suburban Baseball League proudly presents the WSBL Skills competition and All Star games for 10, 11, & 12 year old players on Saturday, May 12, at Central Park, 450 Forest Gate Road, Oak Brook.

The event will begin at 2 p.m. with four skills competitions at each level. The 10U and 11U All Star Games will be played at 5 p.m., while the 12U All Star Game is slated for 7:30 p.m.

Here is the complete schedule for the day:

### **Around-the-Horn (Field #1, 2 p.m.)**

Each team of four players will start at home, throw to third, throw to second, throw to first, and then back home. Each player must tag base with foot (a 3-second penalty will be assessed for missing a base). Each team will get 2 rounds, with best time posted.

### **Target Competition (Field #4, 2 p.m.)**

Each player (2-3 players per team) will throw five baseballs from the outfield to a target at home plate. Balls hitting the target will be awarded 1 point, and balls in the strike zone will be awarded 3 points.

### **Home Run Hitting Contest (Field #3, 2:30 p.m.)**

Each player (three players per team) will be given 10 swings for home runs with a maximum of 15 pitches.

### **Fastest Base Runner (Field #2, 2:30 p.m.)**

Each player (2-3 players per team) will start at home plate and run around the bases. A 3-second penalty for missing a base.

Trophies will be awarded for first place and runner up for each skills competition at each age level.

### **10-Year-Old All-Star Game (Field #2, 5 p.m.)**

The WSBL North All Stars vs. the WSBL South All Stars.

### **11-Year-Old All-Star Game (Field #3, 5 p.m.)**
