WSBL Regular Season Enters Final Weeks

West Suburban Baseball League teams continued to battle for second-half honors as the league's inaugural season entered in final month.

At the 12U level, the Illinois Lightning, Roselle Renegades and Wheaton-Briarcliffe Blazers are battling for the North-Gold division title. In the North-Silver division, the Winfield Wolves and Streamwood Bulldogs were tied with 3-1 marks for the second half.

The LaGrange Panthers had a one game lead over the Lisle Wolves and Riverside-Brookfield Bulldogs in the South-Gold. The Plainfield Hornets, at 3-0, set the pace in the South-Silver.

At the 11U level, the Lisle Wolves remain the class of the league with an impressive 7-0 record in the second half to lead the American Division. The Elmhurst Cougar, also undefeated in the second half, led the National Division.

Tights Races at 10U Level

Just one-half game separates the top three teams in the 10U South Division, The Clarendon Hills Cardinals and Elmhurst Cougars are tied at 5-1, with the Lisle Wolves on their heels at 5-2. In the North Division, the Winfield Wolves at 5-2 were out in front of the Warrenville Warriors and Bloomingdale Bulldogs.

WSBL Post-Season Tourneys Around the Corner

Final preparations are under way for WSBL post-season tournaments at all three age levels. Teams at the 10U and 11U levels are scheduled to begin play the week of June 11, with 12U teams in action the following week. Last-minute, unanticipated scheduling issues will necessitate that early-round games be played at fields other than Oak Brook's Central, Managers who have available fields over the next two weeks are encouraged to contact their age-level WSBL commissioner.
