Lisle Wolves Roar to 11U Tournament Title

The Lisle Wolves were the class of the West Suburban Baseball League's 11U division during the second-half of the 2007 regular season, and they drove home that point loud and clear with their performance in the post-season tournament.



The Wolves defeated the Wheaton Warriors 21-4 Sunday in Elmhurst to claim the inaugural 11U tournament championship. The Wolves posted wins over Bloomingdale (11-1), Oak Brook (9-3) and Glenside (9-5) in pool play, then defeated Glenside 5-3 in a semifinal contest. Lisle ended the season with a 14-game winning streak, nine regular season games and five in the tournament. In that span the Wolves outscored their opponents 179-44.

Runner-up Wheaton took a difficult route to get to the championship game. The Warriors dropped their opening tournament game to Elmhurst, but came back with wins over LaGrange, Hinsdale and, in the semifinals, Wheaton-Briarcliffe.

The Glenside Raiders claimed third place in the 11U tournament, while the Wheaton-Briarcliffe Blazers took home the fourth-place hardware.

Oak Brook Outlaws Blast Way to 10U Championship

Scoring 46 runs would be a good week's work for many baseball teams. But not for the Oak Brook Outlaws.



The Outlaws needed just three games – post-season tournament games, no less – to score 46 runs on their way to the West Suburban Baseball League's 10U championship Saturday night in Oak Brook.

The Outlaws' offense was operating on all cylinders during the tourney. Oak Brook posted impressive wins over Clarendon Hills (17-3) and Elmhurst (11-4) to advance to the title game. The Outlaws won the crown with an 18-9 win over the Hinsdale Red Dogs.

Hinsdale reached the championship game on wins over Bloomingdale (10-5), Roselle (16-15) and Darien (7-4).

The Elmhurst Cougars took third-place honors in the 10U tournament, while Darien placed fourth.
